Phase III: \$5 Million Goal

The Healing Begins Here at Southton Campus

The primary building, "Old Main" or as it will be now be named the "**Red McCombs Recovery Center**" will be remodeled to provide residential care in a residential hall setting.

Phase Three of our Building for Recovery campaign will consist of new plumbing, HVAC and electrical upgrades, the renovation of two residential halls, the remodeling of a family & community center, a large auditorium, counseling offices and group rooms.
